Candidates who want to seek the DCDC's endorsement must fill out this questionnaire and be interviewed by the committee to undergo an assessment of overall suitability, reliability, character, and conduct, to hold the office being sought. We will also review what to expect as a candidate from the DCDC.

These interviews will serve as our best effort to present the voters with the most viable candidates, while strengthening the potential of electing qualified Democratic candidates and uniting our Democratic Party in Dauphin County behind one candidate for each ballot position. Also included in the packet are informational flyers for our Nomination Petition/New Voter Law Workshop on January 22, 2020, and our Endorsement Meeting on February 22, 2020.

Please fill out the informational form and return it to the DCDC by **Monday, January 20, 2020**. We want to hold the interviews on January 15 (5:30pm - 8:30pm and January 25 (10am – 1pm). You will receive a link to sign up for a time for one of these two days once we receive your completed application.
