

Dear 2026 Democratic Candidate:

In 2025, Dauphin County didn't just turn a deeper shade of blue — it made history! From courtroom benches to county offices and township boards, our Democratic candidates shattered ceilings and built bridges to a more inclusive future. These victories included:

- ➤ La'Tasha Williams, Esq. became the first Black woman elected to the Dauphin County Court of Common Pleas and, along with Katy Kennedy-McShane, Esq., the first Democratic women elected to that court in 30 years.
- > Antonio Carreno became the first Democrat and Hispanic elected as Prothonotary.
- > Tina Nixon became the first Black woman elected to a Dauphin County row office.
- > Binita Rai made history as the first Bhutanese-American woman to serve as a Swatara Township Commissioner.
- ▶ Derry Township and Lower Paxton Township both flipped Democrat a monumental change, as Lower Paxton is the largest voting bloc in the county and once a Republican stronghold. The Lower Paxton Board of Supervisors is now entirely Democratic.
- > Swatara Township expanded its Democratic majority, defeating two Republican incumbents; four of the five board members are now people of color.
- Middletown Borough elected a Democratic mayor and two Democratic council members, flipping local leadership blue.

Now, it's time for 2026. To keep this momentum going, the Dauphin County Democratic Committee (DCDC) is calling on committed Democrats like you to consider running for office. There are several key seats on the ballot for 2026. The DCDC will endorse the following offices: **Congress (10th District), State Senate (34th District), and State House of Representatives (103rd, 104th, 105th, 106th, and 125th Districts).** Your leadership could be the next chapter in our story of progress!
